ISSUE: WATER STATION #4 NITRATE REMOVAL SYSTEM

PURPOSE:

Looking for council approval to award water station #4 nitrate removal system project to the best bid.

BACKGROUND:

The Nitrate Removal System at water station #4 is approximately 30 years old and ready for replacement. This is the only station that has a nitrate removal requirement. The indoor tanks' controls and piping will be replaced. The outdoor salt tank will be overhauled.

DISCUSSION:

During the month of February 2023, we solicited bids from water treatment contractors, and received only one bid. Staff reviewed the bid and found it to be acceptable and reasonable. There is \$150,000 in the budget for this line item, the additional funds will come from FY2024 budget.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Town staff recommends the Town Council to approve replacing the Water Station #4 Nitrate Removal System in the amount of \$222,157.5 to Stoner Enterprises Inc. using available budgeted funds for "Salt Water Tank" in FY23 and FY24 budgets.
