

**THE TOWN OF MOUNT AIRY
ORDINANCE NO. 2023-6**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2022-7, WHICH ADOPTED AND APPROVED THE BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF MOUNT AIRY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023.

FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE BUDGET BY ADDING \$6,000 TO THE GENERAL FUND OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE TOWN ELECTION THAT WILL TAKE PLACE ON MAY 2, 2023, WITH FUNDS COMING FROM THE GENERAL FUND OPERATING SAVINGS ACCOUNT.

WHEREAS, the Town is required to hold an election at the end of a Councilmembers four year term; and

WHEREAS, in Fiscal Year 2022-2023 three councilmember's terms will expire and the Town will have an election on May 2, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Town budgeted for the election expenses but due to the rising costs of voting equipment additional funds are needed; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to allocate funds for the expenses of the town election; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Mount Airy Adopted Ordinance 2022-7 adopting the Budget for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 for the Town of Mount Airy on May 2, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to amend Ordinance 2022-7 as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE AUTHORITY AFORESAID that the Town of Mount Airy Budget for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 be, and hereby is, amended to add \$6,000 to the General Fund Operating Budget, line item 01-502-5107, Election Expenses, with funding coming from the General Fund Operating Savings account; and that all other provisions of Ordinance 2022-7 shall remain unchanged and as is.
