

**THE TOWN OF MOUNT AIRY  
ORDINANCE NO. 2023-7**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2022-7, WHICH ADOPTED AND APPROVED THE BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF MOUNT AIRY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023.

FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE BUDGET BY ADDING \$8,350 TO THE STREETS & ROADS CAPITAL BUDGET FOR COST ASSOCIATED WITH THE STORM WATER MANAGEMENT MANDATED PROJECT FOR THE EAST-WEST STORM WATER MANAGEMENT FACILITY WITH FUNDING COMING FROM A GENERAL FUND RESERVE INVESTMENT ACCOUNT.

WHEREAS, the East-West Storm Water Management Facility Project has been an ongoing project mandated by the State of Maryland that began in Fiscal Year 2020-2021 with engineering services, continued with a complete retrofit into Fiscal Year 2021-2022; and

WHEREAS, outstanding invoices were not sent to the Town in a timely manner and therefore were not budgeted for in Fiscal Year 2022-2023; and

WHEREAS, the outstanding invoices must be paid in Fiscal Year 2022-2023; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to allocate funds for these expenditures as required by the Town Code; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Mount Airy Adopted Ordinance 2022-7 adopting the Budget for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 for the Town of Mount Airy on May 2, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to amend Ordinance 2022-7 as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE AUTHORITY AFORESAID that the Town of Mount Airy Budget for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 be, and hereby is, amended to add \$8,350 to the Streets & Roads Capital Budget, line item 01-514-5947, East-West Storm Water Management Facility, with funding coming from a General Fund Reserve Investment account; and that all other provisions of Ordinance 2022-7 shall remain unchanged and as is.
