

**THE TOWN OF MOUNT AIRY  
ORDINANCE NO. 2019-10**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2019-3, WHICH ADOPTED AND APPROVED THE BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF MOUNT AIRY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020.

FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE BUDGET BY ADDING \$90,000 TO THE GENERAL FUND CAPITAL BUDGET FOR THE MAIN STREET SIDEWALK PROJECT WITH FUNDS COMING FROM A STREETS & ROADS RESERVE ACCOUNT.

WHEREAS, the Main Street Sidewalk Project is a multi-year project that began late in Fiscal Year 2018-2019 and will continue into Fiscal Year 2019-2020; and

WHEREAS, the total funds allocated for this project in Fiscal Year 2018-2019 were not spent; and

WHEREAS, the funds not expended in Fiscal Year 2018-2019 will be needed to complete the total project in Fiscal Year 2019-2020; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to provide funding to finish this project in Fiscal Year 2019-2020; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Mount Airy Adopted Ordinance 2019-3 adopting the Budget for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 for the Town of Mount Airy on May 6, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to amend Ordinance 2019-3 as follows:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Mount Airy Budget for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 be, and hereby is, amended to add \$90,000 to the Roads Capital Annual Sidewalk, Curb & Gutter Project line item for the Main Street Sidewalk project, with funding coming from a Streets & Roads Reserve Investment Account; and that all other provisions of Ordinance 2019-3 shall remain unchanged and as is.
