ISSUE: MANHOLE REHABILITATIONS PROJECT #2020-MA-G-012

### **PURPOSE:**

Town staff is seeking Council approval to award the Manhole Rehabilitations project to the bid that is in the best interest for Mount Airy.

### **BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:**

Inflow and Infiltration (I&I) has been an issue in the Town for many years and has been an increasing issue in recent years. While prior rehab work has made substantial improvements to the Town's sewer collection system, this year we took a more direct approach, which involved night work and defining more exact locations where the I&I is coming from. This project is the first step in providing a solution to those issues that were recently found.

The Town solicited bids for the Town from utility contractors during the month of March. Numerous contractors viewed the bid online and the Town received three (3) acceptable bids from contractors in March.

W.F Delauter & Son, Inc. was the lowest, responsive bidder as shown in the attached bid review. There are fixed costs and unit costs and the total amount will depend on the number of manholes and other resources provided. The proposed budget amount for I&I work in FY2021 is \$200,000.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

Town staff recommends the Town Council to award the Manhole Rehabilitations project #2020-MA-G-012 to W.F Delauter & Son, Inc. in the amount of up to \$200,000.
