

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for:

Date of notice

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water meets health standards. During the **January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2024** monitoring period, we did not fulfill fluoride monitoring and/or reporting requirements. Therefore, we cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

- We failed to monitor for fluoride during the January 2022 to December 2024 period.
- We failed to report fluoride results prior to the reporting deadline.

Provide additional explanation as needed:

The laboratory responsible for collecting and analyzing our drinking water samples failed to collect the triennial fluoride samples, resulting in a missed monitoring requirement. Although this was a violation of monitoring regulations, there is no immediate risk to the safety of your drinking water. Current and historical data indicate fluoride results to be below the MCL.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

What is being done?

Additional testing will be conducted during 2025.

We anticipate returning to compliance by 3/13/2025.
